

He shall also satisfy himself that they are in working order by trying and using the levers and seeing that the switch of the points fits properly and truly to the stock rail. 37. All facing points on main line shall be secured by a padlock or other locking device. 38. The Driver shall bring the train to a stand in front of all facing points unless signalled forward. 39. The Station Master shall be responsible that all facing points over which a train will pass are correctly set and locked and trailing points correctly set. 40. No Driver shall take an engine upon or across the main line without being signalled by the person in charge of the points. 41. Drivers shall exercise great care in passing over facing points and shall see that they are properly set. 42. The condition of the hand signal and of other lamps and flags in the possession of the Station Staff shall receive the careful attention of the Station Master, who shall be held responsible for seeing that lamps are kept clean and well trimmed.
